Program Specifics

The purpose of this Research Program is to help high school students strengthen academic skills through research and therefore increase their chances of university admissions.

In this Program students work in small groups on a research topic under the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). Each research team has the support of a research advisor. The program is one-year long, from January to November 2024. Each team will produce a high-quality research paper that will be peer reviewed and published.

Students collaborate

through weekly research meetings, group work, and independent work, approximately 6 hours per week in total. All meetings, discussions, and teamwork are done remotely via Zoom and Google collaborative apps. No traveling is needed. Each team creates their own meeting and work schedules in consideration of team members' time zones
